
Sponsor Forms were sent home in book bags this week so please look out for them. On the day we'll be sending children home with a sticker of how many bounces they did.

You may have noticed construction vehicles on the roads near school.

As some of you may be aware, there is a new development being built at the end of the cul-de-sac of Wolfs Wood, by construction company Vulcan Ellis.

Demolition of existing dwelling will take place to make way for a new housing development of 12 homes.




#### **Reception Screening Tests**
